# Volunteer Positions

Please mark any positions below that you might be interested in.

- Greeter:** Answer the phone, help clients feel welcome and assist the counselor/s with the flow of clients. This may include some data entry and filing. Commitment would require at least two, 4 hour shifts per month.
- Clothing Room Attendant:** Helps keep clothing room organized; sort through donated items and sort by size, gender and season. Set schedule not required, no minimum commitment required.
- C.A.R.E. Group Facilitator:** Co-lead a 10 week Bible study program focused on post-abortive healing. The time commitment would require attending a 12 week training program and co-leading at least one 10 week program.
- Options Counselor:** Meet with clients individually; assess needs, give information, oversee self administered pregnancy test and complete the required paperwork. Extensive training provided and required for this position. Commitment would require at least two, 4-hour shifts per month after completion of training.
- Public Relations:** Distribute literature and answer questions at our booth in fairs or malls. No minimum commitment required.
- Special Project Crew:** Light “handyman” activities or projects (painting, pressure washing etc.) as needed. No minimum commitment required.
- Church Ambassador:** Responsible for getting permission and announcing Emergency Pregnancy Services information to their congregation. He/She would work as a liaison with their church office to get information into church bulletins, promote our annual diaper drive collection, recruit volunteers for the center and/or encourage the church to get involved with fundraising events at the center.
- Landscaping:** Help beautify our center by planting flowers or shrubs. No minimum commitment required.
- Mail Prep:** Help fold, seal and apply address labels to our quarterly newsletter. Stuff envelopes with inserts, seal and apply address labels to our fundraising mail outs. Four hour shifts will be scheduled sporadically during the year. No minimum commitment required.
- Donation Pick up:** We are occasionally offered donations of cribs and nursery furniture without a way to pick the items up. We are in need of volunteers that wouldn't mind picking up the items and bringing them to the center a few times a year. No minimum commitment required.
